SATURDAY – July 21 2007

RULES: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 edition.

ELIGIBILITY: All boats with a 2007 PHRF- ELI rating certificate and one-design keelboats racing in their one design division are eligible.

START TIME: The first gun (warning for first division to start) will be at **5:00 P.M. local time.**

START: In Shelter Island Sound. The start is between the RC boat (flying RC flag and yellow pennant) and a drop mark

FINISH: Between the **Breakwater in Sag Harbor** and the committee boat.

COURSE: Courses **Point to Point** depending on the division and wind conditions. Instructions and scratch sheets will be available at the Breakwater Yacht Club, on a race committee boat or on the internet at breakwateryc.org prior to the race. A large course board on the starboard side of the race committee will be used to indicate each Division's course and starting order.

SCORING: Scoring will be based on corrected times using the PHRF rating system in conjunction with the **time on time** methodology 650/(550+ PHRF).

DIVISIONS: **Spinnaker, non-spinnaker and one-design divisions** (if sufficient boats enter to form a one design division- minimum 5 boats).

ENTRY FEE: \$45.00 for the event. Deduct \$5.00 if a member of US Sailing and \$10.00 if a 2007 PHRF- ELI certificate is submitted with entry. Entries must be submitted to Carol Morse at 421 North Main St. Southampton N.Y. 11968. All entries **shall** be received by 12 noon, Friday, July 20th. **A donation of \$25.00 per boat is requested for those wishing to attend the party**

AWARDS: Trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each division will be awarded as well as the Spindrift perpetual trophy **There will be a cocktail party and results at the Breakwater Yacht Club following racing.**
