**Notice of Regatta**  
**2007 Summer Series**

**June 6, 13, 20, 26, July 4, 18, 25, August 1, 8, 15, 22, 29 and September 5**  
**(July 11 will be the Oz Race – females at the helm- not part of Summer Series)**

**1. Rules**

- 1.1 The U.S. Sailing Association's Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 edition will govern this regatta.

**2. Eligibility**

- 2.1 All competitors must:
- 2.1.1 Be members in good standing of Breakwater Yacht Club
  - 2.1.2 Have paid the entry fee
  - 2.1.3 Have submitted the signed captain's waiver
  - 2.1.4 Have provided proof of insurance
  - 2.1.5 Submit a valid ELIYA PHRF 2007 certificate prior to or within one week of competing in your first race.
- 2.2 Visiting yachts may enter at a cost of \$15.00 per individual race but will not be scored for the series.
- 2.2.1 Eligibility to race for visiting yachts is up to the discretion of the Regatta Committee.
- 2.3 ***No competitor will be scored without fulfilling all eligibility requirements prior to the race. There will be no retroactive scoring.***

**3. Fees**

- 3.1 \$155 for US Sailing Members
- 3.2 \$160 for non-US Sailing members

**4. Divisions**

- 4.1 Division 1: Non-sprit Spinnaker boats
- 4.2 Division 2: Sprit Spinnaker boats
- 4.3 Division 3: Non-Spinnaker

**5. Registration**

- 5.1 Entry is good for the yacht named on the entry only -no substitutions allowed.
- 5.2 **Entries can be mailed to: Joan Worthing, 104 S. Magee St., Southampton, NY 11968, handed to Joan W. or Carol Morse directly, or placed in the RC box in the BYC office.**
- 5.3 Entry forms will be available at the Breakwater Yacht Club and from the website, [www.breakwateryc.org](http://www.breakwateryc.org).

**6. Courses**

- 6.1 All races will be run in Shelter Island Sound.
- 6.2 Courses will be displayed from a board on the committee boat.

**7. Start**

The first gun will be sounded at 6:00 PM local time in the area west of Majors Cove in Shelter Island Sound.

**8. Scoring**

- 8.1 For each division, the low point scoring system (U.S. Sailing rules Appendix A – using A9 modified to count DNS, DNF, RAF, DSQ, and OSC as scored equal to the number of boats coming to the starting area and keeping DNC scored as 1 more than the number of boats entered in the series) will be used.
- 8.2 A boat's best scores for 60% (rounded regularly) of the series will be used for the series scoring.
- 8.3 Penalties are applied to the Time Correction Factor (TCF) for last year's 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers in each division.

9. **Prizes** for 1st 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded in each division.

**10. Changes**

- 10.1 Changes to the Notice of Race may be posted on the BYC clubhouse notice board prior to the race.
