**Notice of Regatta**  
**2008 MAY CUP**  
**MAY 7, 14, 21 and 28**

- 1. Rules**
  - 1.1 The U.S. Sailing Association's Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 edition will govern this regatta.
- 2. Eligibility**
  - 2.1 All competitors must:
    - 2.1.1 Be members in good standing of Breakwater Yacht Club, including all regular crew members
    - 2.1.2 Have paid the entry fee
    - 2.1.3 Have submitted the signed captain's waiver
    - 2.1.4 Have provided proof of insurance
    - 2.1.5 Hold a valid ELIYA PHRF 2007 certificate submitted by May 21<sup>st</sup>.
  - 2.2 Visiting yachts may enter at a cost of \$15.00 per individual race but will not be scored for the series.
  - 2.2.1 Eligibility to race for visiting yachts is up to the discretion of the Regatta Committee.
  - 2.3 ***No competitor will be scored without fulfilling all eligibility requirements prior to the race. There will be no retroactive scoring.***
- 3. Fees**
  - 3.1 \$45 for US Sailing Members
  - 3.2 \$50 for non-US Sailing members
- 4. Divisions**
  - 4.1 Division splits to be Non-spinnaker or Spinnaker only.
- 5. Registration**
  - 5.1 **Entries can be mailed to Joan Worthing, 104 S. Magee St., Southampton, NY 11968, handed to Joan Worthing directly, or placed in the RC box in the BYC office.**
  - 5.2 Entry is good for the yacht named on the entry only - no substitutions allowed.
  - 5.3 Entry forms will be available at the Breakwater Yacht Club and from our website [www.breakwateryc.org](http://www.breakwateryc.org).
- 6. Courses**
  - 6.1 All races will be run in Shelter Island Sound.
  - 6.2 Courses will be displayed from a board on the committee boat.
- 7. Start**

The first gun will be sounded at 6:00 PM local time in the area west of Majors Cove in Shelter Island Sound.
- 8. Scoring**
  - 8.1 For each division, the low point scoring system (U.S. Sailing rules Appendix A – using A9 modified to count DNS, DNF, RAF, DSQ, and OSC as scored equal to the number of boats coming to the starting area and keeping DNC scored as 1 more than the number of boats entered in the series) will be used. One throw out will be used in each division.
- 9. Prizes** for 1st 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded in both divisions
- 10. Changes**
  - 10.1 Changes to the Notice of Race may be posted on the BYC clubhouse notice board prior to the race.
