1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-1208 edition.
- 1.2 Vessels racing in a One Design Division will be governed by their class rules.
- 1.3 The regatta is governed by the 2009 General Conditions of ELIYA

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.3 All boats with a 2009 PHRF- ELI rating certificate or one-design keelboats racing in their one design division under class rules are eligible.
- 2.4 One Design boats with a valid 2009 PHRF-ELI certificate are eligible to be scored for the Sag Harbor Cup Perpetual Trophy.

3. ENTRY FEE

- 3.1 \$100.00 (\$50 of the fee is a tax deductible charitable donation) – 2 party tickets included.
- 3.2 Deduct \$5.00 if a member of US Sailing.
- 3.3 Deduct \$10 for submission of 2009 PHRF – ELI Rating Certificate

4. ENTRY DEADLINE

- 4.1 Entries must be submitted to Joan Worthing at 104 S. Magee St., Southampton, NY 11968, BYC at P.O. Box 2601, Sag Harbor, NY 11963, or online. All entries **shall** be received by 12 noon, Monday, August 10, 2009.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Saturday, August 15, 2009

7. START TIME

- 7.1 The first gun (warning for first entrant to start) on Saturday will be determined by the entrant with the highest PHRF rating. Therefore the boat with the lowest rating will be the last to start. (Probably around 10am for 1st warning gun)
- 7.2 Each entrant will have a unique starting time determined by their PHRF rating.
- 7.3 Vessels with the same PHRF Rating will be on the starting line at the same time (One Design).

8. **START**
 - 8.1 In Shelter Island Sound approximately 1NM ESE of G15.
9. **FINISH**
 - 9.1 The finish will be in the vicinity of the start in Shelter Island Sound.
10. **COURSE**
 - 10.1 The course will be either a clockwise or counterclockwise circumnavigation of Shelter Island. There may be an alternate course if there is not enough wind.
11. **SCORING**
 - 11.1 This is a pursuit race. Your finish place will be your score! If the race is shortened or an alternate course is used, then time-on-time will be used for scoring.
12. **DIVISIONS**
 - 12.1 **Boats will be scored in Spinnaker, non-spinnaker and one-design divisions** (if sufficient boats enter to form a one design division - minimum five boats).
13. **AWARDS**
 - 13.1 **There will be an awards ceremony at the Breakwater Yacht Club @6:30pm and a party starting earlier (5:30pm). There will be a \$25 fee per person for access to the open bar and food. (2 tickets are included with the entry fee)**
 - 13.2 The coveted Sag Harbor Cup will be awarded as well as trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each division plus many others including and not limited to awards for slowest circumnavigation, navigational errors (groundings), best crew uniforms, best boat theme, best yacht club finishes and many more!
14. **MISSION**

The net proceeds from this regatta are dedicated to the Breakwater Junior Sailing Program. This program gives scholarships for the local children of our community to attend to our sailing program. All tax deductible donations to this worthy program will be greatly appreciated! Please help us to continue our efforts to truly be a community sailing center!
15. **DOCKING AND MOORING**
 - 15.1 Breakwater Dock will be available for overnight dockage for visiting participating boats on a first reservation basis. As many boats as can be accommodated must reserve a position in advance and agree to allow another boat to tie-on.
